## **Assembly Directions**

Congratulations on your purchase of a Nintendo $^{\rm B}$  brand Super Mario $^{\rm TM}$ ! Some assembly is required before your Mario is ready for use. This assembly should take between 10-15 minutes. You will need the following tools:


- Screwdriver
- 5/16" bolt driver
- Jowl Tool (included)

## **Directions**

- 1. Affix the hat to the head assembly. Hat should snap into place when even pressure is applied. Do not force the hat into place, or damage could result.
- 2. Place the head assembly onto the jowl. Be sure that it is facing the correct direction before proceeding! Using the enclosed Jowl Tool, tighten the lock bolts through the holes under the jowl. Once the bolts are tightened, the jowl cannot be removed.
- 3. Slide the left arm (shown on the right side of the diagram) into the slot provided on the torso assembly. You will hear a click when it is properly connected.

- 4. Hold the left hand under the newly attached arm and insert 2 of the enclosed screws under it. Screw them both in partially, then tighten both to ensure an even joint.
- 5. Repeat #3 with the right arm.
- 6. Repeat #4 with the left hand.
- 7. Place the left foot against the bottom of the torso assembly so the holes line up. Insert one of the bolts through the bottom of the foot. Tighten until firm.
- 8. Repeat #7 for right foot.
- 9. Lower head assembly (with attached jowl) onto torso assembly top. Pinch the clips on the sides of the joint and push firmly down until you hear a snap. The head is now attached.

Note: Head can be replaced easily by pinching the clips to remove the expended head and replacing it with a fresh one. Use only Nintendo brand Super Mario Heads, as generic replacements can permanently damage the unit.
